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Community Dialogue_Safety and Security

There were seven community members which included two board members, one administrator, and two classified staff.

- I gave an update on the district obtaining a School Resource Officer (SRO) from the Village of Loudonville. The agreement between the Village and the school district is being worked out at this point. There are some legal aspects that need to be in writing.
- I also updated the group on obtaining more liaison hours from Appleseed Counseling. Again, there are some financial and legal aspects that need to be in writing.
- A question was raised about “Stop the Bleed” kits that will be in every classroom this fall. There is specific training that staff members must have before the kits can be placed in the classrooms. Cafeteria staff will also be trained as well as the teaching staff.
- Discussion about a permanent solution to the HS. This solution is a large concept and target area. We will be focusing on the safety at the HS as we progress. This is certainly a main focus.
- The group had a large discussion about the traffic flow between the Budd School and McMullen Elementary. Principals Gorrell and Seboe will be looking into this situation all year. The intent to try to fix the chaos that occurs at the beginning of the school day and at the end.
 - Topics in this discussion included: crossing guards, who can and who cannot direct traffic on State Route 3, Safe Routes to School- phase 2?
