Notifications:

The school district is required to notify all volunteers of the following information:

- The Board of Education has purchased liability insurance coverage that includes volunteers. The names of all volunteers will be kept on file in the Superintendent's Office.
- Under legislation that took effect on March 22, 2001, Boards of Education and most other agencies and organizations serving children are now required to notify all volunteers who have "unsupervised access to a child" on a regular basis that they MIGHT be subjected to a criminal records check (AM. Sub. S.B. 187, 123<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly). This notification is required not only for new applicants but also for volunteers who are already serving in the schools. "Unsupervised access to a child" is defined as any indoor situation in which there is no other person 18 years of age or older present in the same room, or any outdoor situation in which no other person 18 years of age or older is within a 30-yard radius of the child or has visual contact with the child. "On a regular basis" is not defined, nor is the term "volunteer".
